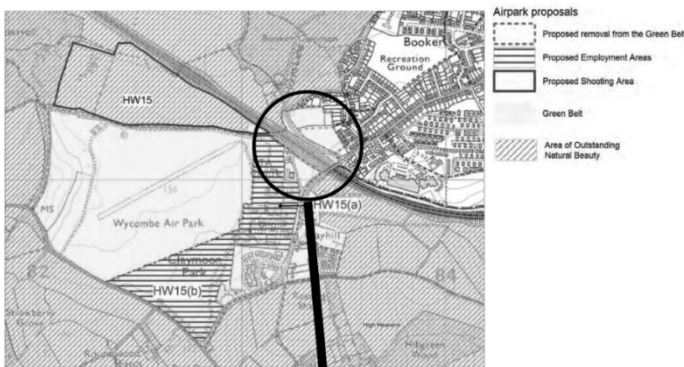

## New Council Plan Make your views clear



Remove from  
Green Belt

New Houses

Traveller Site

The new Council Plan for Booker includes a proposal to remove a large area of land from Greenbelt. Most of this is in the airpark but the proposal also includes land outside the airpark on both sides of the motorway.

This additional land is earmarked for up to 50 new houses and a traveller site.

The proposal, including the commercial development on the airpark would create a line of development across the motorway and into an area surrounded by AONB. The road network, already overcrowded, could not cope and would inevitably lead to further development of the roads, loss of more green belt and the eventual loss of AONB and the unique countryside that is so important.

**The Committee of the BCWPS encourages you to object to this development which would change the area in which we live for ever. The stadium proposal was defeated, together we can defeat this proposal too.**
